ORDER

This Court having been requested by the Circle of Respect Shelter and the Domestic Violence Programs in the State of Wyoming for a waiver of the filing fee and licensing requirements for advocates and the Court finding good cause therefore;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pursuant to the authority of the Court to adopt rules to carry out the Family Protection Code, the following Rules of Court are hereby adopted to govern all complaints and cases under the Family Protection Code initiated by the Circle of Respect or by any Domestic Violence Program of the State of Wyoming.

RULE OF COURT NO. CV-102
WAIVER OF FILING FEE

a. The filing fee for all complaints initiated by the Circle of Respect or any Domestic Violence Program of the State of Wyoming shall be waived by the Court upon proof that the victim is represented by said program(s).

b. Proof of indigency need not be shown.

c. Said waiver shall apply to all subsequent orders enforcing an ex parte order or order of protection.

d. This rule shall be effective immediately upon the adoption thereof.


RULE OF COURT NO. CV-103
WAIVER OF LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

a. Employees of the Circle of Respect and any Domestic Violence Program of the State of Wyoming shall not be required to obtain a license to represent victims of domestic violence in the Shoshone and Arapahoe Tribal Court.

b. This rule shall be effective immediately upon the adoption thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court Administrator shall make this order and these rules available for public inspection and copying at no charge.
