ORDER ADOPTING RULE AD-103

To Whom It May Concern:

The Shoshone and Arapahoe Tribal Court hereby finds that a need exists for advocates practicing be aware of recent developments in law in order to serve their clients in a competent manner; and as a result they should be required to obtain at least fifteen hours of training each year.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following rule is adopted.

RULE OF COURT AD-103

In order to remain in good standing as an active member of the Wind River Bar Association each advocate shall show proof that they have received at least fifteen (15) hours of training in the areas of civil, criminal, juvenile or appellate law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court Administrator shall make this order and rule available for public inspection and copying.
