ORDER ADOPTING RULE CR-106

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Shoshone and Arapaho Tribal Court finds that a procedure is needed to expunge the record of convictions beyond five (5) years.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that pursuant to the authority designated in Rule 37(1) Rules of Criminal Procedure, Shoshone and Arapaho Law and Order Code (SALOC) and Rule 4-6-15 Records; Confidentiality, SALOC and to implement expungement of records of convictions, the following Rule of Court be and the same is hereby adopted to govern all expungements that meet the criteria in the following rule.

**RULE OF COURT NO. CR-106
EXPUNGEMENT OF RECORDS OF CONVICTION**


- 1) **Petitioner** – a person who has pleaded guilty, nolo contendere or has been convicted of an offense prohibited by tribal law, may petition the Shoshone and Arapaho Tribal Court for expungement of the record of convictions, subject to the following limitations:
 - a. At least five (5) years have elapsed since the expiration of the terms of the sentence imposed, including any periods of probation, completion of any program ordered, payment of restitution or payment of fines and payable sentences;
 - b. The offense which the person is seeking to be expunged shall not have involved the use of or attempted use of a firearm;
 - c. The filing fee shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00);

2) **Tribal Prosecutor**- duties

- a. A copy of the petition shall be given to the Tribal Prosecutor who shall then decide whether or not to notify any victims.
- b. The Tribal Prosecutor shall review the petition and may file an objection within ten (10) days of receipt of the petition. If an objection is filed the court will set a hearing.
- c. If no objection is filed the Court may summarily enter an order granting expungement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court Administration shall make this order and rule available for public inspection and copying at no charge.
