OF FOREIGN ORDERS FOR PROTECTION)

This Court having determined that protection of victims of domestic violence is important to the Wind River Indian Reservation and that under the Federal Violence Against Women Act (VAWA), courts from different jurisdictions can recognize, honor and enforce the other's orders for protection.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pursuant to the inherent authority of this Court to make appropriate rules, the following rule is hereby adopted:

RULE OF COURT NO. CV-109
RECOGNITION AND ENFORCEMENT OF
FOREIGN ORDERS FOR PROTECTION

a. Registration and enforcement of foreign orders for protection.

1. A certified copy of an order for protection issued by a state, federal, or tribal court may be filed in the office of the clerk of court. The clerk shall act upon the order in the same manner as the as the clerk acts upon an order for protection issued by this Court.

2. An order for protection filed in accordance with subsection 1 has the same effect and must be enforced in the same manner as an order for protection issued by this Court.

b. Duties of the clerk of court shall be:


1. Maintain a registry in which to enter certified orders

for protection issued by a state, federal or tribal court that are received for filing; and

2. At the request of a person who is affected by or has a legitimate interest in an order for protection, certify and forward a copy of the order to that court or person at no cost to the requesting party.

c. The Court shall enforce all provisions of a registered foreign order for protection whether or not such relief is available in this Court.
